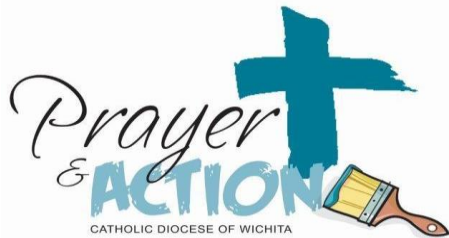

Padre Pio Visit - April 13, 2018

The relics of Saint Pio available for public veneration will be the following: Saint Pio's glove; Saint Pio's crusts of the wounds; Cotton-gauze with Saint Pio's blood stains; A lock of Saint Pio's hair; Saint Pio's mantle; Saint Pio's handkerchief soaked with his sweat hours before he died.

The relics will be at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception of the Diocese of Wichita, on Friday, April 13, 2018, from 7 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Bishop Carl A. Kemme will celebrate a Mass in honor of Saint Pio at 7 p.m.

The Saint Pio Foundation, which is sponsoring the tour on the occasion of the 50th commemoration anniversary of his passing, will sell books and items related to Padre Pio in the entryway of the Cathedral.

Camp is open to any student in grades 5-12, Catholic or not, from the Diocese of Wichita and beyond. Camp Totus Tuus is hosted at Camp WaJaTo in Lyons, Kansas.

Early Bird Pricing

BEFORE May 1, 2018, the cost to attend camp is as follows:

5th/6th camp: \$175

7th-12th camp: \$275

AFTER May 1, 2018, the cost is as follows:

5th/6th camp: \$190

7th-12th camp: \$300

Deposit (1/2 of total camp fee) is due upon registration to reserve camper's spot on roster. Total balance is due two weeks prior to camp.

Cancellation policy: Deposit is **non-refundable**. Total amount paid is **non-refundable** within two weeks prior to camp.

Scholarships are available. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until funds are exhausted. Applicants must submit the scholarship application along with a letter from the parent and camper.
